Through a partnership with the Maine Department of Education, EnGen provides career-aligned English instruction to prepare participants for CNA training.

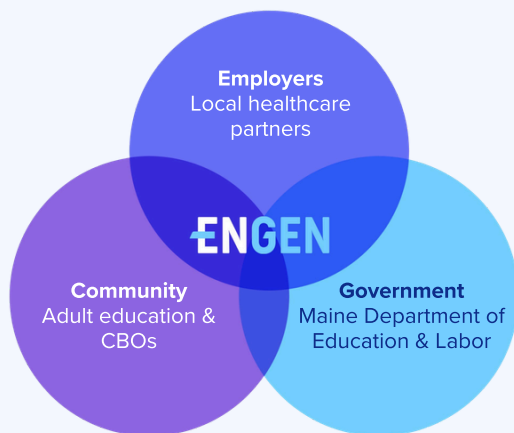
Industry Credentials
